



Monterey Peninsula Landfill, Monterey, California

Blower and Flare Design, Permitting and Installation

Project Profile

Background

To ensure compliance with applicable rules and regulations, the Monterey Regional Waste Management District (MRWMD) hired DEI to design, procure and install a blower system and flare capable of handling all landfill gas anticipated to be generated over the life of the Monterey Peninsula Landfill.

DEI Scope of Work and Team Activities

- Establishing the design basis for the blower and flare;
- Preparation of a Request for Proposal (RFP) and conduct a bid for the provision of equipment;
- Preparation of RFP documents and specifications and conduct a bid for the equipment installation;
- Acquisition of building permits;
- Manage the manufacture and delivery of equipment;
- Construction management including:
 - Site preparation,
 - Equipment installation, and
 - Start up and commissioning

Results

- Approval for a replacement CUP by the County Board of Supervisors was granted on February 6, 2007
- All approvals and permits for the City side of the landfill were received in July 2005 and operations were restarted on the City side of the property.
